

### **GROUNDS COMMITTEE**

Fall greens aerification is complete for 2023. The staff concluded this process over a two-day period, September 18th & 19th. We pulled sod cores, cleaned up the plugs, top dressed with sand and finally brushed the sand into the holes.

Greens have been rolled numerous times to help smooth out playing surfaces and are now being mowed. We fertilized and sprayed nutrients that will help with the healing process too. The only remaining project to be completed this year is aerification of approaches and fairways.

We appreciate your patience during this process! Although inconvenient, it is an absolute necessity for healthy playing areas. It prepares and protects the golf course as we enter into the winter months and continuing through to the beginning of next growing season. Thanks again for your understanding!
