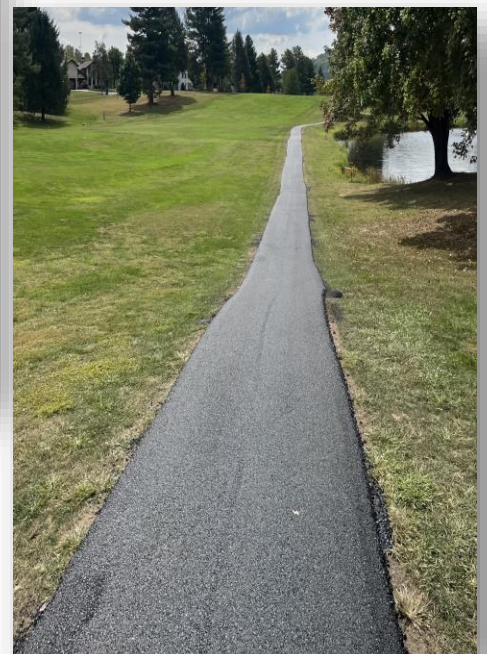
GROUNDS COMMITTEE

Bridgeport High School the Class AAA Region II golf championship this afternoon at the Bridgeport Country Club.

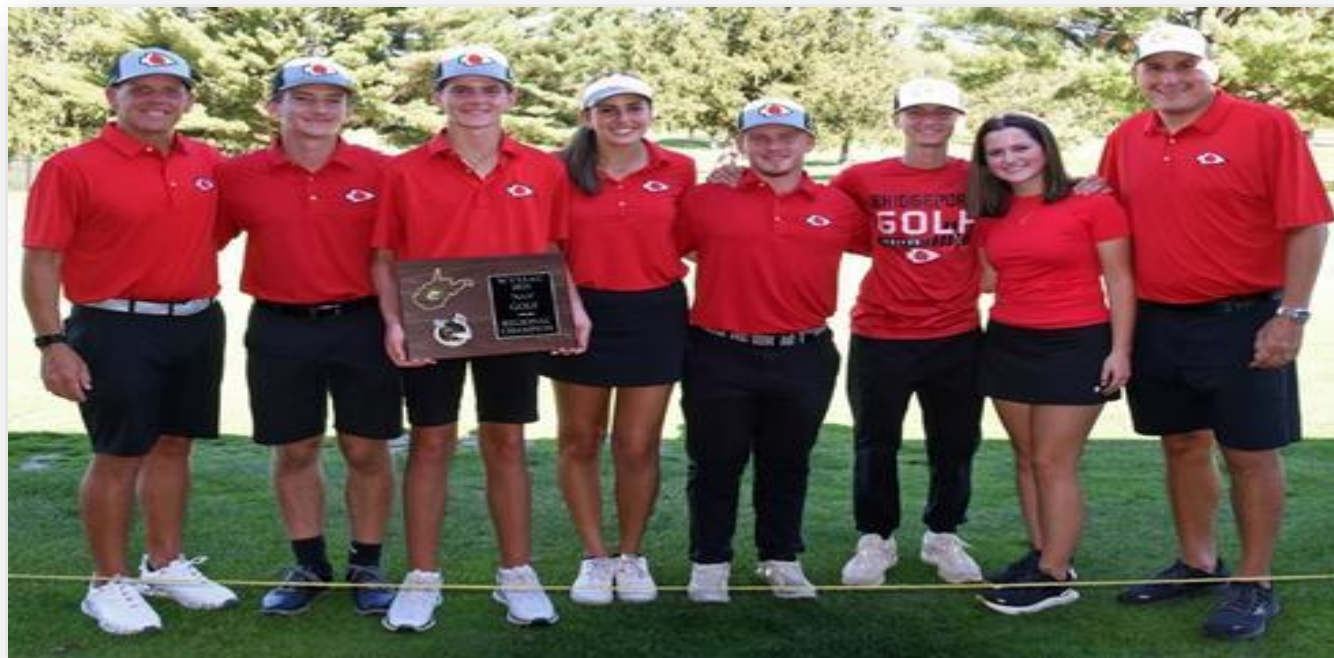
The Indians won the region by 13 strokes. The Tribe finished with a total of 228 to get past runner-up Hampshire County, who finished at 241. Keyser came in third with a 217.

"It couldn't be prouder of these kids," said Coach Chris Kerr. "They worked hard all season and before that in the offseason in the Callaway tournaments and others. It's nice to see them rewarded for that work, but we still have some work to do."

Bridgeport was led by a monster afternoon by freshman Alexander Randolph. Randolph was the low medalist during the competition with 68. Teammate and junior Audrey Kerr tied for the second-best score of the day with a 76. Hampshire's Peyton Vanmeter also finished at 76.

The team will now look to capture a state championship for the Indians. They will compete at the state championship match to be held at Oglebay Resort in Wheeling on The Jones Course at Speidel Golf Club.

Play begins on Tuesday, Oct. 14 and concludes on Wednesday, Oct. 15.
